Absentee bids

If you are unable to attend an auction, you may submit an absentee bid form and our auction staff will bid for you. They will try to bid just as you would, obtaining the item at the lowest bid possible. Absentee bid forms are found online on our website - www.baranovich.org. You may also bid through a friend or agent.

How to place an absentee bid

To place an absentee bid, please fill out both sides of the form provided. Please indicate the lot number(s), a brief description and the amount you wish to bid for each item. If you wish to bid to the next increment in case of a tie, please place a check in the box provided. In the event identical bids are submitted, the earliest bid received will take precedence. Therefore, please place your bids as early as possible.

Buyer's Premium

The amount you indicate on the bid form is solely for the hammer price. Please remember that a 25% premium will be added to the successful bid price of each lot you purchase and is payable by you. For more information on payment, please refer to the *Conditions of Sale*.

Bidding by telephone

We can arrange for you to bid live by telephone. To arrange for live telephone bidding, please contact us well in advance of the auction.
